Application Process for 2020 International Teams

1. **Introduction.** This document invites applications for the following 2020 international full-bore teams:

a. **UK Cadet Rifle Team – U17 (UKCRT): 12 firers.** Competes annually in Jersey. Provisional dates for 2020 are 16 to 24 August. Selection and training is carried out during Maple Taste.

b. **British Cadet Rifle Team – U18 (BCRT – known as The Athelings): 18 firers.** Competes annually in Canada. Provisional dates for 2020 are 4 to 29 August. Selection is carried out towards the end of 2019 based on shooting performance and personal reports. Training is carried out during Maple Taste.

c. **GB U19 Rifle Team: 8 firers.** Competes annually in the Republic of South Africa (RSA). This is not a cadet team but an official GB representative team which CCRS organises in conjunction with the NRA. **Applications are invited from both cadets and non-cadets.** Provisional dates for 2020 are 20 March to 12 April. Selection and training is carried out from 10 to 13 October 2019.
