The Open Units' Smallbore Rifle Competition 2019-20 Rules and Conditions

1. The Open Units' Smallbore Rifle Competition for 2019-20 is organised jointly by the NSRA and CCRS for open units of the UK cadet forces. All rounds are to be fired using the L144A1 Cadet Smallbore Target Rifle, as issued.

2. **Prizes.** The following prizes are associated with this competition:

a. **Inter Service Final.**

- 1st The Punch Trophy and 8 NSRA Gold Medals.
- 2nd 8 NSRA Silver Medals.

b. **The Sea Cadet Corps.**

- 1st The National Trophy and 4 NSRA Gold Medals.
- 2nd 4 NSRA Silver Medals

c. **The Army Cadet Force.**

- 1st The News of the World Challenge Cup and 4 NSRA Gold Medals.
- 2nd 4 NSRA Silver Medals

d. **The RAF Air Cadets.**

- 1st The Battle of Britain Challenge Cup and 4 NSRA Gold Medals
- 2nd 4 NSRA Silver Medals

Additionally, the cadets attending the final will compete for the Shell Trophy.

3. **Timings.** Upon receipt of your entry form, the NSRA will distribute the relevant paperwork and stickers along with further instructions for the competition. Teams will compete within the following timescales. Any team unable to meet the requirements for reasons they consider out of their control must immediately inform the NSRA or CCRS who will make a decision.

Stage 1	Teams to complete within a period of twenty-eight days from the first shot of the first firer or by 2 Dec 19, whichever is the sooner. Cards to be at the NSRA appointed scorer by last post on 9 Dec 2019.
Stage 2	The top 50% of each service entry will fire a second card. Teams to complete within a period of twenty-eight days from the first shot of the first firer or by 10 Feb 20, whichever is the sooner. Cards to be at the NSRA appointed scorer by last post on 17 Feb 2020.
Final	The top two teams from each service will be invited to compete in the Punch Trophy and Shell Trophy on 4 Apr 2020. All firers in the Punch Trophy will be eligible for service Colours.

4. **Teams.** Firing teams are to consist of four firing cadets from the same SCC District, ACF County, or ATC Wing, with at least three in the firing team from the same SCC Area, ACF Company or equivalent, or ATC Sector. Units may enter more than one team. A cadet may only be in one team, but, if transferred to another unit, may continue to shoot for the team in subsequent rounds. A cadet may substitute for another in the second or subsequent stage but must be eligible to shoot in that team. All firers must be under 18 on 4 Apr 2020.

5. **Targets.** Only the following NSRA cards may be used. Photocopies are not acceptable.

Range:	25m	25 yard	20 yard	15 yard
Target:	25M10BM/89-18	2510BM/89-18	2010BM/89-18	1510BM/89 with or without a -18 suffix

Each firer completes one card. Shots must not be gauged or targets otherwise interfered with by units.

6. **Rifles and Equipment.** Only L144A1 as issued may be used. Slings are permitted. The rifle may not be fired off a rest.

7. **Dress.** Shooting jackets, elbow pads (with or without straps) and gloves are allowed. MTP or CS95 must be worn under the shooting jacket; if it is not available then the following dress applies:

8. **Coaching.** Spotting and coaching is allowed by any person, who is also permitted to adjust the sights but may not load for the firer.

9. **Entry.** The entry fee is £8 per team. Entries close 9 November 2019 and should be made on the attached entry form, which should be returned by post to the NSRA or a scanned copy by email to competitions@nsra.co.uk.
