INTER SERVICE CADET RIFLE MEETING (ISCRM): 08 - 10 Jul 22

1. **Introduction.** The Inter Service Cadet Rifle Meeting is a National competition for units of the Sea Cadet Corps, Volunteer Cadet Corps, Army Cadet Force and RAF Air Cadets. This year it will take place at Bisley from 08 - 10 Jul and will be fired using the L81A2 Cadet Target Rifle (CTR).

2. **Competition details.**

Thu 08 Jul	Team arrival and briefing
Fri 09 Jul - Sun 10 Jul	Practice, Individual and Team competitions at 300x, 500x & 600x
Sun 10 Jul	Inter Services Final & Prizegiving (1300)

3. **Competition Rules.** All competitions will be fired in accordance with the ISCRM rules. A copy of the rules can be found on the CCRS website under 'Competitions and Events' - 'Match Rules and Procedures'. <https://ccrs.org.uk/match-rules-and-procedures>.

- a. **Team composition.** Teams must consist of four cadet firers who must be from the same SCC District, ACF County or RAFAC Wing. At least three firers must be in the same SCC Area, ACF Company or RAFAC Sector. Teams are permitted to bring one reserve. They must be under 18 on the day of any competition they compete in. Further details can be found in the Match Rules, para G6.

4. **Entry Form.** Units wishing to enter a team(s) are to submit their entry via the online form which can be found at the following link: [ISCRM ENTRY FORM](#). The entry form will close on **Friday 03 June**.

5. **Accommodation & messing.** Teams will be accommodated and fed at Brunswick camp. Please indicate in the form whether you require accommodation and feeding. Please note that feeding for teams not staying at Brunswick will be subject to availability.

6. **Pre-ISCRM.** Due to lack of range availability at Pirbright/Ash/Barossa, the single Services will be planning and running independent Pre-ISCRM training away from Bisley. For further details please contact:
