## CCF SCHOOLS' MEETING 2022: 11 - 14 Jul 22

1. **Introduction.** The CCF Schools' Meeting is a National competition for Combined Cadet Forces. This year it will take place at Bisley from 11 - 14 Jul and will be fired using the L81A2 Cadet Target Rifle (CTR) with issued Parker Hale sights.

## 2. Competition details.

Sun 10 Jul	Team arrival, team managers' briefing and Schools' Committee meeting
Mon 11 Jul - Wed 13 Jul	Competitions at 300x, 500x & 600x
Thu 14 Jul	Ashburton Day & Prizegiving

3. **Competition Rules.** All competitions will be fired in accordance with the CCF Schools' Meeting rules. A copy of the rules can be found on the CCRS website under 'Competitions and Events' - 'Match Rules and Procedures'. <u>https://ccrs.org.uk/match-rules-and-procedures</u>.

a. **Team composition.** Any number of cadet firers of any age from a UK or Channel Island contingent of the CCF or from a UK or Channel Island unit of the SCC, ACF or ATC providing such unit is open only to members of the school from which the cadets are drawn. Further details can be found in the Match Rules, para G7.

4. **Entry Form.** Schools wishing to enter are to submit their entry by completing the Excel Entry Form attached which can also be found at the following link: <u>CCRS downloads</u>. All forms are to be returned to <u>competitions.officer@ccrs.org.uk</u> by **Wednesday 15 June**.

5. **NRA-run extras.** Entry to Clay, Gallery Rifle and Cadet 1K are available again this year. These are to be booked directly with the NRA. <u>https://online.nra.org.uk/imperial153-schools</u>

6. Accommodation & messing. Teams will be accommodated and fed at Brunswick camp if required. Please indicate in the form whether you require accommodation and feeding. Please note that feeding for teams not staying at Brunswick will be subject to availability. Due to a change in MOD Policy, packed lunches are not available for range day. All units messing at Brunswick must bring Single Meal Rations (SMR) for lunches from unit stores except 14 Jul (Ashburton Day).

7. **Messing contribution.** Messing contribution apply to all cadets if taken at Brunswick. £2.24 per cadet per day where a meal is taken. Messing will be collected separately after your Nominal Roll is returned. Cadets in receipt of unemployment allowance, and CFAV, do not pay messing.

8. **Cost.** Entry fees are automatically calculated on the entry form. Payment is to be no later than 24 June to CCRS by BACS (sort code 16-19-26, account 10454956). Please reference your payment with: School Name/C2680. Please contact CCRS if you require an invoice.
