CADET IMPERIAL: 19 – 24 July 2024

1. **Introduction.** The Cadet Imperial was introduced in 2016 as a bridge from the traditional cadet fullbore shooting at the Inter Services' Cadet Rifle Meeting (ISCRM) or the CCF Schools' Meeting to the NRA Imperial meeting. It allows cadets and CFAV to compete as individuals on Century Ranges alongside the NRA Imperial competitors, with a high level of supervision and assistance. NRA medals are presented to the winners of each individual competition, and the cadet with the highest aggregate score over the meeting wins free entry into the 2025 NRA Imperial.

2. **Eligibility.** All cadets aged 14 or 15, senior cadets transitioning to CFAVs and cadet adults who are ambitious and wish to grow their target shooting performance.

3. **Rifles and ammunition.** L81A2 Cadet Target Rifle (CTR) and MoD issued ammunition.

4. **Application and entry fees**. Applications are invited now from units/schools for cadets and cadet adults. Entries will cost £60 per person. Applicants are to submit their entry via the online form which can be found at the following link: <u>ENTRY FORM</u>. The entry form will close midnight **Monday 3 June**.

Once selections are confirmed, payment is to be made no later than 01 July to CCRS by BACS (sort code 16-19-26, account 10454956). Please reference your payment with: Name/C2660.

5. **Duty of care/pastoral supervision.** Cadets taking part will remain at Bisley at the end of ISCRM and the Schools' Meeting. Those not in the company of parent unit/school adults will be supervised throughout by dedicated staff.

6. **Staff requirement.** CFAV who wish to help support the event can find more information or apply for the Cadet Bisley Permanent Range Team (PRT) and Cadet Support Group (CSG) by contacting the Shooting Office. Funding for this is via single Service VA policy.

7. **Administrative arrangements.** All personnel will be accommodated and fed at Brunswick. Detailed administrative instructions will be issued in mid-June.

8. **Competition detail.** The competition will be conducted by CFAV range staff to the same match conditions as the NRA Imperial. Cadets and CFAVs will shoot as self-coached individuals. The competition will consist of individual matches fired at 300, 500 and 600 yards. Firers will be expected to mark targets for part of the time to help keep costs down. The Cadet Imperial is not a substitute for the NRA Imperial and cadets intending to put themselves forward for selection for a cadet national team should shoot the NRA Imperial competition.

9. **Competition Rules.** All competitions will be fired in accordance with the Cadet Imperial rules. A copy of the rules can be found on the CCRS website under 'Competitions and Events' - 'Match Rules and Procedures'. <u>https://ccrs.org.uk/match-rules-and-procedures</u>.
