## INTER SERVICE CADET RIFLE MEETING (ISCRM): 11-14 July 2024

- 1. **Introduction.** The Inter Service Cadet Rifle Meeting is a national tri-Service competition for units of the Sea Cadet Corps, Volunteer Cadet Corps, Army Cadet Force and RAF Air Cadets (ATC). This year it will be shot again at Bisley from 11-14 Jul and will be fired using the L81A2 Cadet Target Rifle (CTR).
- 2. Competition details.

- 3. **Competition Rules.** All competitions will be fired in accordance with the ISCRM rules. A copy of the rules can be found on the CCRS website under 'Competitions and Events' 'Match Rules and Procedures'. <a href="https://ccrs.org.uk/match-rules-and-procedures">https://ccrs.org.uk/match-rules-and-procedures</a>.
  - a. **Team composition.** Teams must consist of four cadet firers who must be from the same SCC Area, ACF County or RAFAC Wing. Teams are permitted to bring one reserve. They must be under 18 on the day of any competition they compete in. Further details can be found in the Match Rules, para G6.
- 4. **Entry Form.** Units selected to enter by their single Service lead are to submit their entry via the online form which can be found at the following link: <u>ISCRM ENTRY FORM</u>. The entry form will close on Monday 03 June at 0900. No changes will be accepted within 5 days of the event (i.e. after Sun 07 Jul).
- 5. **Accommodation & Messing.** Teams will be accommodated and fed at Brunswick Camp. Please indicate in the form whether you require accommodation and feeding. Please note that feeding for teams not staying at Brunswick will be subject to availability. CFAV and cadets form homes in receipt of unemployment allowance do not pay messing.
- 6. **Pre-ISCRM.** For ACF details, please contact Lt Col M Roberts, National Shooting Advisor Army Cadets. For SCC and RAFAC, pre-ISCRM will be run 07- 11 Jul under single Service leads as per pre-COVID on the Pirbright and Ash Range complexes. For further details please contact:
