## CALLING NOTICE - CADET INTER-SERVICES SKILL AT ARMS MEETING (CISSAM) 27-30 OCT 22

1. **Introduction.** The Cadet Inter-Services Skill at Arms Meeting (CISSAM) is a national competition for units of the Sea Cadet Corps, Volunteer Cadet Corps, Army Cadet Force and RAF Air Cadets. This year it will take place at Pirbright Ranges from 27-30 Oct 22 and will be fired using the L98 A2 Cadet General Purpose Rifle. It will follow directly on from a re-scheduled ISCRM (see CCRS 8005-2 dated 25 Aug 22).

### 2. Competition Outline.

Thu 27 Oct (pm)	Team arrival and briefing
Fri 28-Sat 29 Oct	Competitions
Sun 30 Oct	Falling Plates, Inter Services Final, Prizegiving and dispersal

3. **Competition Rules.** All competitions will be fired in accordance with the CISSAM rules V1.2. A copy of the rules can be found on the CCRS website under 'Competitions and Events' - 'Match Rules and Procedures'. [Match Rules and Procedures – CCRS – Council for Cadet Rifle Shooting](#).

- a. **Team composition.** Teams must consist of four cadet firers who must be from the same SCC District, ACF County or RAFAC Wing. At least three firers must be in the same SCC Area, ACF Company or RAFAC Sector. Teams are permitted to bring one reserve. They must be under 18 on the day of any competition they compete in. Further details can be found in the Match Rules, para 6.
- b. **Cadet Butt Markers.** Each team is to bring one cadet as a butt maker to work on the Gallery Range.

4. **Entry Form.** Units wishing to enter a team(s) are to submit their entry via the online form which can be found at the following link: [CISSAM ENTRY FORM](#). The entry form will close at **0900hrs on Friday 30 September**.

PLEASE NOTE THAT DUE TO THE VERY CONSIDERABLE AMOUNT OF WORK INVOLVED IN DELIVERING ISCRM AND CISSAM BACK-TO-BACK THIS YEAR, IT IS VITAL THAT TEAM MANAGERS RESPECT THE DATES AND TIMINGS OUTLINED IN THIS CALLING NOTICE. NO ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER 30 SEPTEMBER. IF IN DOUBT, CONTACT CCRS SHOOTING MANAGER ON [shooting.manager@ccrs.org.uk](mailto:shooting.manager@ccrs.org.uk).

5. **Team Selection and Nominal Roles.** Confirmation of teams selected to compete at CISSAM will be communicated to Team Managers by CCRS on **Monday 03 Oct**, when Team Managers will also receive a Nominal Roll template which must be completed and returned to CCRS **no later than 10 Oct**. After this date changes may not be possible.

6. **Accommodation & Messing.** Teams will be accommodated and fed at Brunswick camp. Please indicate in the form whether you require accommodation and feeding. Please note that feeding for teams not staying at Brunswick will be subject to availability. **Due to a change in MOD Policy, packed lunches are not available for range days. All units messing at Brunswick must bring Single Meal Rations (SMR) for lunches from unit stores or make other arrangements.**

7. **Qualifying Scores.** Qualifying shoots and score are controlled by the single Service Shooting Leads. For further details please contact:

8. **Cost.** Entry fees per team of 4 cadets are broken down as follows:

9. **Staff.** The three single Services are each responsible for running one range each (already allocated). 10. **Summary of Actions Required.**

- By 0900 hrs Fri 30 Sep 22. Apply using link at Para 4 above.
- By Mon 10 Oct. Assuming that your team entry is confirmed by CCRS on Mon 03 Oct, complete and return Team Nominal Roll(s), using CCRS template.
- 17 Oct. Pay entry fees.
- 27-30 Oct. Attend CISSAM.

## Conclusion

11. Following feedback from Service units and from CCRS's Inter Services Matches Committee, it is expected that some units will wish to shoot both ISCRM and CISSAM, and some units will wish to shoot one or the other. The Joining Instructions for each event (to be issued early October) will confirm how this will be managed.
