CALLING NOTICE - INTER SERVICE CADET RIFLE MEETING (ISCRM) 24 - 27 OCTOBER 2022

1. **Introduction.** The Inter Services Cadet Rifle Meeting (ISCRM) is a national competition for units of the Sea Cadet Corps, Volunteer Cadet Corps, Army Cadet Force and RAF Air Cadets, normally held at Bisley in July. Having had to cancel the ISCRM in July this year owing to range fires and following consultation with CCRS's Inter Services Matches Committee and the respective Cadet Forces' Shooting Leads, it has been agreed to re-schedule ISCRM 2022 from 24 - 27 Oct 22, prior to CISSAM (27-30 Oct 22). The ISCRM will be fired using the L81A2 Cadet Target Rifle (CTR).

2. Competition Outline.

Mon 24 Oct Team arrival and briefing.

Tue 25 Oct - Thu 27 Oct Practice, Individual and Team competitions at 300X, 500X & 600X.

Thu 27 Oct Inter Services Final & Prizegiving, dispersing pm, less for those staying on

for CISSAM (see Para 13 below).

- 3. **Competition Rules.** All competitions will be fired in accordance with the ISCRM rules. A copy of the rules can be found on the CCRS website under 'Competitions and Events' 'Match Rules and Procedures'. https://ccrs.org.uk/match-rules-and-procedures. A copy is also attached to this Calling Notice.
 - a. **Team composition.** Teams must consist of four cadet firers who must be from the same SCC District, ACF County or RAFAC Wing. At least three firers must be in the same SCC Area, ACF Company or RAFAC Sector. Teams are permitted to bring one reserve.
 - b. **Age requirement.** Cadets must be under 18 on the last day of the competition. Due to exceptional circumstances this year, and as agreed by a majority vote of the Inter Services Matches Committee, cadets who would have been under 18 for the ISCRM originally scheduled in July 2022 may take part. This will be for honours only, and their scores will not count towards team totals or the Cadet 100. Further details can be found in the Match Rules, para G6.
- 4. **Entry Form.** Units wishing to enter (a) team(s) are to submit their entry via the online form which can be found at the following link: <u>ISCRM ENTRY FORM</u>. The entry form will close **at 0900hrs on Friday 30 September**.

PLEASE NOTE THAT DUE TO THE VERY CONSIDERABLE AMOUNT OF WORK REQUIRED PRIOR TO ISCRM, INCLUDING CORRECT SQUADDING AND THE DETAILED ALLOCATION OF ACCOMMODATION, NO ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER 30 SEPTEMBER. IF IN DOUBT, CONTACT CCRS SHOOTING MANAGER ON shooting.manager@ccrs.org.uk.

- 5. **Team Selections**. Depending on the number of team entries, and subject to any considerations by the Inter Services Matches Committee, it may be necessary for single Services to select teams to come forward to ISCRM. This will be done on 3 October.
- 6. **Team Confirmation and Nominal Rolls.** CCRS will confirm teams to come forward to ISCRM on Monday 3 October, and will issue a template to Team Managers for teams to complete team nominal rolls. **Completed team nominal rolls must be returned no later than Monday 10 October**. After this date, changes may not be possible.
- 7. **Qualifying scores.** Qualifying shoots and scores are controlled by the single Service Shooting Leads. For further details please contact:

- 8. **ACF Qualifying Card.** Qualifying cards can be downloaded from the CCRS website at the following link: https://ccrs.org.uk/downloads/ Cards are to be returned to Capt P Bayley.
- 9. **Accommodation & Messing.** Teams will be accommodated and fed at Brunswick camp. Please indicate in the form whether you require accommodation and feeding. Please note that feeding for teams not staying at Brunswick will be subject to availability. **Due to a change in MOD Policy, packed lunches are not available for range days. All units messing at Brunswick must bring Single Meal Rations (SMR) for lunches from unit stores or make other arrangements.**
- 10. **Cost.** Entry fees per team of 4 cadets are broken down as follows:

Entry Fee (including NRA markers) £95 per team

Cadet Messing Contribution £35.84 per team (4 cadets, 4 x days)

Reserve Cadet Messing Contribution £8.96

- By Mon 10 Oct. Assuming that your team entry is confirmed to you by CCRS on Mon 03 Oct, submit Nominal Roll (CCRS template).
- 24-27 Oct. Compete at ISCRM!

Conclusion

13. All Team Managers should note that CISSAM will assemble pm 27 Oct, and that CISSAM (Service Rifle) will be competed 28-30 Oct, dispersing pm 30 Oct. Following discussion with Inter Services Matches Committee, and consultation by single Service Shooting Leads, it is expected that some teams will wish to shoot both ISCRM and CISSAM, but also that some teams will wish to shoot ISCRM only, and others CISSAM only. A separate Calling Notice for CISSAM is issued in parallel with this Calling Notice for ISCRM.
