CALLING NOTICE - CADET INTER-SERVICES SKILL AT ARMS MEETING (CISSAM) & CCF SKILL AT ARMS MEETING (CCF SAM) 26-29 OCT 23

1. **Introduction.** The Cadet Inter-Services Skill at Arms Meeting (CISSAM) is a national competition for units of the Sea Cadet Corps, Volunteer Cadet Corps, Army Cadet Force and RAF Air Cadets. This year it will take place at Pirbright Ranges from 26-29 Oct 23 and will be fired using the L98 A2 Cadet General Purpose Rifle. This year the CCFSAM will be shot concurrently with CISSAM.

2. Competition Outline.

Thu 26 Oct (pm)	Team arrival and briefing
Fri 27-Sat 28 Oct	Competitions
Sun 29 Oct	Falling Plates, Inter Services Final, Prizegiving and dispersal

3. **Competition Rules.** All competitions will be fired in accordance with the CISSAM rules V1.1. A copy of the rules can be found on the CCRS website under 'Competitions and Events' - 'Match Rules and Procedures'. Due to range constraints this year Match 1, 8 & 9 have been removed and Match 11 added as a replacement. Match Rules and Procedures – CCRS – Council for Cadet Rifle Shooting.

- a. **Team composition.** Teams must consist of four cadet firers who must be from the same SCC District, ACF County or RAFAC Wing. At least three firers must be in the same SCC Area, ACF Company or RAFAC Sector. Teams are permitted to bring one reserve. They must be under 18 on the day of any competition they compete in. Further details can be found in the Match Rules, para 6.
- b. **Cadet Butt Markers**. Will not be required as all matches will use SARTs.

4. **Entry Form.** Units wishing to enter a team(s) are to submit their entry via the online form which can be found at the following link: <u>CISSAM/CCFSAM ENTRY FORM</u>. The entry form will close at **0900hrs on Monday 02 Oct 23**.

PLEASE NOTE THAT DUE TO THE SHORTENED TIMELINES, IT IS VITAL THAT TEAM MANAGERS RESPECT THE DATES AND TIMINGS OUTLINED IN THIS CALLING NOTICE. NO ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER 02 OCTOBER. IF IN DOUBT, CONTACT CCRS SHOOTING MANAGER ON <u>shooting.manager@ccrs.org.uk</u>.

5. **Team Selection and Nominal Roles.** Confirmation of teams selected to compete at CISSAM will be communicated to Team Managers by CCRS on **Tuesday 03 Oct**, when Team Managers will also receive a Nominal Roll template which must be completed and returned to CCRS **no later than 9 Oct.** After this date changes may not be possible.

6. **Accommodation & Messing.** Teams will be accommodated and fed at Brunswick camp. Please indicate in the form whether you require accommodation and feeding. Please note that feeding for teams not staying at Brunswick will be subject to availability. Lunches will be packed meals.

7. **Qualifying Scores**. Qualifying shoots and score are controlled by the single Service Shooting Leads, in accordance with sS polies all cadets must have complete CLF GP 13 and the CISSAM Match 3 or Commonwealth Match E Course of Fire before entering, these and WHTs must be recorded on WESTMINSTER or BADER. 8. **Cost.** Entry fees per team of 4 cadets are broken down as follows:

9. **Staff.** The three single Services are each responsible for running one range each (already allocated). 10. **CFAVs.** All CFAVS must have a current DBS check, Safeguarding Training and Climatic Illness training recorded on either WESTMINSTER or BADER by 9 Oct.

- By Mon 09 Oct. Assuming that your team entry is confirmed by CCRS on Tue 03 Oct, complete and return Team Nominal Roll(s), using CCRS template.

- 26-29 Oct. Attend CISSAM.
