NATIONAL CFAV CLAY TARGET SHOOT: 26-28 April 2024

INTRODUCTION

1. The eighth National CFAV Clay Target Shoot, is a shoot for units of the Combined Cadet Forces, the Sea Cadet Corps, the Army Cadet Force and the Air Training Corps and will take place at the Cambridge Gun Club's Shooting Ground, Cottenham, Cambridge CB24 8AH on **26-28 April 2024**. Accommodation for Individuals who request it will be made available where possible at Cambridge ACF's CTC Waterbeach. Those that do not wish to stay at the CCRS accommodation must find their own accommodation and anyone who may wish to travel in each day, must notify their intentions.

EVENT DETAILS

- 2. All competitors MUST attend the brief on the range at 0930 with the CFAV competition starting at 1000 on the Saturday and continuing through Sunday. Dress for the competition is appropriate CIVILIAN clothing to include safety glasses and hearing protection. It is highly recommended that a baseball type (peaked) cap is worn as well.
- 3. The Individual Championships will consist of the following shot under CPSA Rules:
 - a. 100 Bird Sporting;
 - b. 25 Bird Down the Line (DTL);

There will be a trophy for each discipline. In addition, the leading individual with the highest aggregate of the Sporting and DTL will receive the High Gun trophy. Firers will be grouped into categories dependent on experience and previous attendance at the competition. The committee will decide the categories.

4. There will be a concurrent Team Competition for teams of 3 from one unit consisting of the aggregated scores achieved in the individual competitions plus the flurry. Team members must be identified before firing commences.

ENTRY

5. Units wishing to enter a team / or individual for the Championships are to submit their entry via the LINK, by 1 April 2023 accompanied by entry fee payment. Late entries are unlikely to be accepted. Guest shooters may be invited by the Clay Target Shooting Committee after the closing date to shoot for honors only.

- 7. All competitors must provide their own cartridges, plastic or fiber, to a maximum of 28G shot size 6. Cartridges are available at the ground to license holders. The cost of the competition targets is included in the entry costs.
- 8. There will be practice stands open from 1000, the cost of these targets and cartridges is your responsibility and bills must be settled by the individual before departure from the ground each day.
- 9. If oversubscribed, a refund will be made to any individual that cannot be accepted but refunds will not be made to Individual's who withdraw at short notice, unless they can be replaced by another individual.
- 10. After the closing date, the individuals / teams, whose entries have been accepted, will be notified and will be sent detailed instructions that will require the immediate submission of an accommodation and messing return and other details.
- 11. In the event of bids exceeding the number of vacancies, the Committee will allocate places, and a Reserves List will be created.
- 12. All competitors must be enrolled and serving CFAV's on unit strength with the possible exception of invited guests. Teams may be mixed male/female. All firers must be CPSA Shotgun Skills qualified before firing and it must be entered on Westminster/Bader.
