## **NATIONAL CADET TARGET SPRINT MEETING: 17-19 May 2024**

1. **Introduction.** The first National Cadet Target Sprint Meeting will be held at Holcombe Moor Training Camp, Spenleach Lane, Berry, BL8 4JJ, with thanks to RFCA North-West and Greater Manchester ACF. This event replaces the two evenings of Target Sprint shoots at the ISCRM and the CCF Schools Meeting and is open to all five Cadet Forces. The Meeting will be structured around two separate competitions - the individual races and the team races, with the top 5 individuals from each British Shooting (BS) age group being invited to the UK National Final. Accommodation will be at Holcombe Moor Training Camp.
2. **Competition details.** The program will be based on:
  - a. Saturday Individual Heats.
  - b. Sunday Individual Finals.
  - c. Sunday Team Races.
3. **Prizes.**
  - a. Fastest 11- to 15-year-old male and female.
  - b. Fastest 16- to 18-year-old male and female.
  - c. Fastest Team.
  - d. British Shooting medals for each age category and top team.
4. **Competition Rules:** All competitions will be run in accordance with the British Shooting Target Sprint Rules which can be found at [British Shooting Target Sprint Rules 2023](#).
5. **Entry.** Units wishing to enter individuals and teams for the competition are required to submit their entry on the form at [ENTRY FORM](#) by Friday 26 April. All competitors must attend both shooting days, and as capacity is limited, places will be allocated on a 'first come, first served' basis. Teams whose entries have been accepted will be notified and sent detailed instructions by Wednesday 01 May, and teams will be required at that point to confirm their accommodation and messing return no later than Friday 03 May, along with confirmation of BACS payment (see paragraph 10). The competition will be on WESTMINSTER / BADER (WESTMINSTER Activity Code: CCRS/24/994999) and once notified that your team has been allocated a place, you must ensure that all participants are posted on WESTMINSTER / BADER to ensure that they are recognised as taking part in this cadet activity.

a. **Team composition.** Each team is to consist of four serving cadets and a CFAV team manager, and Westminster/Bader numbers must be included in the paperwork. Teams may be mixed male/female. A team manager may look after more than one team.

b. **Individuals:** the entries will be drawn from the unit teams of 4.

6. **Accommodation and arrival.** Messing will be from breakfast on Saturday to lunch on Sunday only. There will not be an evening meal on the Friday, and accommodation is limited. In the event of bids exceeding the number of teams that can be accommodated, CCRS will allocate places and a reserves list will be created. A refund will be made to any team that cannot be accepted. Personnel must provide their own sleeping systems. Teams are welcome to arrange their own alternative accommodation but must highlight this on the admin paperwork and attend the competition briefs, which will take place on the range at 0930 on the Saturday and the Sunday.

7. **Target Sprint training and qualification.** All cadets must have fired CLF AR5 or AR6 and have an in-date Air Rifle WHT.

8. **Air Rifles and other equipment.** CCRS will provide single shot Air Arm air rifles and ammunition. Teams may bring their own single shot air rifles that meet rule 7.1 of the BS Rules. Multi-shot air rifles are not permitted. Teams are to provide their own issued hearing protection and glasses.

9. **Dress.** Cadets are to wear PT kit with trainers for all races; uniform or boots are not to be worn.

10. **Cost.** Entry fees are £70 per team. Payment is to be made before 01 May to CCRS by BACS (sort code 16-19-26 account 10454956) Reference: Unit Name – C3850.
