## CALLING NOTICE – CADET SKILL AT ARMS MEETING (CadetSAAM), 24-27 OCTOBER 2024

1. **Introduction.** The Cadet Inter-Services Skill at Arms Meeting (CISSAAM) is historically a national competition for units of the Sea Cadet Corps, Volunteer Cadet Corps, Army Cadet Force and RAF Air Cadets firing the L98 A2 Cadet General Purpose Rifle. Given enhanced capacity and following agreement by CCRS's Inter Services Matches Committee (Community Cadets) and CCRS's CCF Schools Committee (CCFs), CCFs will now also compete until further notice at this annual Meeting for separate honours, thus making the meeting a Joint CISSAAM and CCFAAM, which the Committees agreed should be called CadetSAAM (thus distinguishing it from the single Service CADSAAM).

### 2. Competition Outline.

Fri 25-Sat 26 Oct	Competitions
Sun 27 Oct	Falling Plates, Inter Services Final, Prizegiving and dispersal

3. **Competition Rules.** All competitions will be fired in accordance with the CISSAAM rules V1.1. A copy of the rules can be found on the CCRS website under 'Competitions and Events' - 'Match Rules and Procedures'. Due to range constraints this year Match 1, 8 & 9 have been removed and Match 11 added as a replacement. [Match Rules and Procedures – CCRS – Council for Cadet Rifle Shooting](#).

- a. **Team composition.** Open Unit Teams must consist of four cadet firers who must be from the same SCC District, ACF County, RAFAC Wing, and at least three firers must be in the same SCC Area, ACF Company or RAFAC Sector. CCF Teams must also consist of four cadet firers who must be from the same CCF Contingent. All teams are permitted to bring one reserve. Firers must be under 18 on the day of any competition they compete in. Further details can be found in the Match Rules, para 6.
- b. **Cadet Butt Markers.** Will not be required as all matches will use SARTs.

4. **Entry Form.** Units wishing to enter (a) team(s) are to submit their entry via the online form which can be found at the following link: [CadetSAAM ENTRY FORM](#). The entry form will close at **0900hrs on Monday 02 Sept 24**.

5. **Team Selection and Nominal Roles.** Confirmation of teams selected to compete at CISSAAM/CCFSAAM will be communicated to Team Managers by CCRS on **Monday 09 September**, when Team Managers will also receive a Nominal Roll template which must be completed and returned to CCRS **no later than 29 September**. After this date changes may not be possible.

6. **Accommodation & Messing.** Teams will be accommodated and fed at Brunswick Camp. Please indicate in the form whether you require accommodation and feeding. Please note that feeding for teams not staying at Brunswick will be subject to availability. Lunches will be packed meals.

7. **Qualifying Scores.** Qualifying shoots and scores are controlled by the single Service Shooting Leads. In accordance with sS policies all cadets must have completed CLF GP 13 and the Cadet SAAM Match 3 or Commonwealth Match E Course of Fire before entering. These and WHTs must be recorded on WESTMINSTER or BADER. For further details please contact:

8. **Cost.** Entry fees per team of 4 cadets are broken down as follows:

9. **Staff.** The three single Services are each responsible for running one range each (already allocated). 10. **CFAVs.** All CFAVs must have a current DBS check, Safeguarding Training and Climatic Illness training recorded on either WESTMINSTER or BADER by 9 Oct.

- By Mon 29 Sept 24. Assuming that your team entry is confirmed by CCRS on Mon 09 Sept, complete and return Team Nominal Roll(s), using CCRS template.

- 24-27 Oct. Attend CADETSAAAM..
