NSRA Scorers Course 11 Feb 2025

- 1. **Introduction.** CCRS are organizing an NSRA Accredited Scorers Course to inform and instruct applicants on how to score small bore shooting.
- 2. **Details.** The Course will qualify students in the three NSRA grades of scoring, C, B and A. The course will last one day and be made up of the following four areas:
 - a. **Penalties**. There will be guidance/ instructions on identifying errors that require penalties and the effect of the firer's score.
 - b. **Shooting Disciplines.** The course will be focused mainly on .22 Small bore shooting, but also cover Air Rifle scoring.
 - c. **Practical session.** There will be a practical exercise where applicants will practice scoring on example cards.
 - d. **Final Test.** There is an assessment that is done along with the practical work before the NSRA Scorer qualification is awarded.
- 3. Address and arrival. The course will be conducted at Derby Lodge, Bisley Camp, Bisley, Brookwood, GU24 ONY. Students are to report at 0930 and the course finishes at 1630.
- 4. **Messing and Accommodation** are not provided. Students will have to provide their own lunch but there will be brew-making facilities on site. Please contact CCRS Competitions officer at the email below for advice and potential assistance/ advice on accommodation.
- 5. **Cost**. The fee for the course is £15 per applicant and will need to be paid by cheque or by BACS (Account name: CCRS, Sort code: 16-19-26, Account Number: 10454956) upon successful application.
