NATIONAL CADET TARGET SPRINT MEETING: 31 May - 01 Jun 2025

- 1. **Introduction.** The National Cadet Target Sprint Meeting open to all 5 cadet organisations will be held at Cranleigh School, Horseshoe Lane, Cranleigh, GU6 8QQ. This event now replaces the two evenings of Target Sprint shoots previously held at ISCRM and the CCF Schools Meeting.
- 2. The competition will be structured around two separate competitions: the individual races and team races, with the top 5 from each age group, as determined by British Shooting (BS) being invited to the UK National Final.
- 3. **Competition details.** All competitors must attend both shooting days The program will be based on:
 - a. Saturday Individual Heats.
 - b. Sunday Individual Finals.
 - c. Sunday Team Races.

4. Prizes.

- a. Fastest 11- to 15-year-old male and female
- b. Fastest 16- to 18-year-old male and female
- c. Fastest Team
- d. Medals for each age category and top team.
- 5. **Competition Rules:** All competitions will be run in accordance with the British Shooting Target Sprint Rules which can be found at <u>British Shooting Target Sprint Rules 2024</u>.
- 6. **Entry.** Units wishing to enter individuals and teams for the competition are to submit their entry on the form at <u>ENTRY FORM</u>, by **14 April 25 at 0900**. Teams, whose entries have been accepted, will be notified, and sent detailed Joining Instructions. Teams will be required at that point to submit their accommodation and messing return no later than 28 April 25 accompanied with a confirmation of BACS payment to CCRS. The competition will be on Westminster / Bader and once notified your team has been allocated a place, all participants must be posted on Westminster / Bader to ensure that they are recognised as taking part in the cadet activity.

- a. **Team composition.** Each team is to consist of four serving cadets and a CFAV team manager, Westminster/Bader numbers must be included in the paperwork. Teams may be mixed male/female. A team manger may look after more than one team.
- b. Individuals: the entries will be drawn from the unit teams of 4.
- 7. **Accommodation and arrival.** Messing will be from breakfast on Saturday to lunch on Sunday only. There will not be an evening meal on the Friday, accommodation is limited. In the event of bids exceeding the number of teams that can be accommodated, CCRS will allocate places, and a reserves list will be created. Personnel must provide their own sleeping systems. Teams are welcome to arrange their own alternative accommodation but must highlight this on the admin paperwork and be in attendance at the competition briefs which will take place on the range at 0930 on the Saturday and the Sunday.
- 8. **Target Sprint training.** All cadets must have fire CLF AR5 or AR6 and have an in-date Air Rifle WHT.
- 9. **Air Rifles and other equipment.** CCRS will provide single shot Air Arm air rifles. Teams may bring their own single shot air rifles that meet rule 7.1 of the BS Rules, multi shot air rifles are not permitted. Teams are to provide their own issued hearing protection and glasses.
- 10. **Dress.** Cadets are to wear PT kit with trainers for all races, uniform or boots are not to be worn.
- 11. **Cost.** Entry fees are £50 per team. Payment is to be made before 01 May to CCRS by BACS (sort code 16-19-26 account 10454956) Reference: Unit Name C3850.
