INTER SERVICES CADET RIFLE MEETING (ISCRM): 10-13 July 2025

Introduction. The Inter Services Cadet Rifle Meeting is a national tri-Service competition for units
of the Sea Cadet Corps, Volunteer Cadet Corps, Army Cadet Force and RAF Air Cadets (ATC). This
year it will be shot again at Bisley from 10-13 Jul and will be fired using the L81A2 Cadet Target
Rifle (CTR).

2. Competition details.

Fri 11 Jul - Sun 13 Jul Practice, Individual and Team competitions at 300x, 500x & 600x

- 3. **Competition Rules.** All competitions will be fired in accordance with the ISCRM rules. A copy of the rules can be found on the CCRS website under 'Competitions and Events' 'Match Rules and Procedures'. https://ccrs.org.uk/match-rules-and-procedures.
 - a. **Team composition.** As per 2024, teams are to consist of four cadet firers who must be from the same SCC Area, ACF County or RAFAC Wing. Teams are permitted to bring one reserve. They must be under 18 on the day of any competition they compete in. Further details can be found in the Match Rules, para G6.
- 4. **Entry Form.** Units selected to enter by their single Service lead are to submit their entry via the online form which can be found at the following link: <u>ISCRM ENTRY FORM</u>. The entry form will close on Friday 30 May at 0900. No changes will be accepted within 5 days of the event (i.e. after Sun 06 Jul).
- 5. Accommodation & Messing. Teams will be accommodated at Brunswick Camp. Please indicate in the form whether you require accommodation and feeding. Please note that feeding for teams not staying at Brunswick will be subject to availability. Cadets receiving free school meals do not pay messing.
- 6. **Pre-ISCRM**. Pre-ISCRM will be run 06- 10 Jul under single Service leads on the Pirbright and Barossa Range complexes. For further details please contact:

7.	Team Qualifying. All teams must qualify for ISCRM. Qualification matches are under the control of the single Service leads, this is to be a minimum of a 2&7 at 300x and 500x or 600x (CLF TR 4).
8.	Cost. Entry fees per team of 4 cadets are broken down as follows (based on current Cadet DMR):

Entry Fee (including NRA markers) £125 per team

Cadet Messing Contribution £40.80 per team (4 cadets, 4 x days)

PLUS

Reserve Cadet Messing Contribution £10.20

Pre-ISCRM Cadet Messing £12.75 per cadet (5 days inc.)
