NATIONAL CADET TARGET SPRINT MEETING: 10 – 12 APRIL 2026

1. **Introduction.** The National Cadet Target Sprint Meeting will be held from 10-12 Apr 26 at Cranleigh School, Horseshoe Lane, Cranleigh, GU6 8QQ. This competition is open to all five Cadet organisations. The competition will be structured around two separate competitions: the individual races and team races, with the top five from each age group, as determined by British Shooting (BS), being invited to the UK National Final. Accommodation and feeding details will be confirmed after the entries closing date.
2. **Competition details.** The program will be based on:
 - a. Saturday Individual Heats.
 - b. Sunday Individual Finals.
 - c. Sunday Team Races.
3. **Prizes.**
 - a. Fastest 11- to 15-year-old male and female.
 - b. Fastest 16- to 18-year-old male and female.
 - c. Fastest Team.
 - d. Medals for each age category and top team.
4. **Competition Rules:** All competitions will be run in accordance with the British Shooting Target Sprint Rules which can be found at [British Shooting Target Sprint Rules 2026](#).
5. **Entry.** Units wishing to enter individuals and teams for the competition are to submit their entry on the form at [Cadet National Target Sprint Championship 2026 – Fill out form](#) by Fri 27 Feb 26 at 1200hrs. All competitors must attend both shooting days. Teams whose entries have been accepted will be notified and sent detailed instructions. Teams will be required to submit their accommodation and messing return no later than Fri 13 Mar 26. The competition will be on Westminster / Bader and once notified you have been allocated a place, you must ensure that all participants are entered on Westminster / Bader to ensure that they are recognised as taking part in the cadet activity.

In the event of bids exceeding the number of teams that can be accepted, CCRS will allocate places and a reserves list will be created.

- a. **Team composition.** Each team is to consist of four serving cadets and a CFAV team manager. Westminster/Bader numbers must be included in the paperwork. Teams may be mixed male/female. A team manager may look after more than one team.
 - b. **Individuals:** The entries will be drawn from the unit teams of 4.
6. **Accommodation and arrival.** Messing will be from evening meal on Fri 10 Apr to packed lunch on Sun 12 Apr. Accommodation is limited. Personnel must provide their own sleeping systems. Teams are welcome to arrange their own alternative accommodation but must highlight this on their entry form. All team managers must be in attendance at the competition briefs which will take place on the range at 0930hrs on both Sat 11 Apr & Sun 12 Apr.
7. **Target Sprint training.** All cadets must have completed their CLF AR6 and have an in-date Air Rifle WHT.
8. **Air Rifles and other equipment.** CCRS will provide single shot Air Arm air rifles. Teams may bring their own single shot air rifles that meet rule 7.1 of the BS Rules. Multi shot air rifles are not permitted. Teams are to provide their own issued hearing protection and glasses.
9. **Dress.** Cadets are to wear PT kit with trainers for all races; uniform & boots are not to be worn.
10. **Cost.** Entry fees are £50 per team. Payment for the entry fee is to be made by Fri 13 Mar to CCRS by BACS.

Payment for cadet messing & CFAV messing (if claiming VA), will be invoiced after confirmation of the DMR update is published on 01 Apr.
